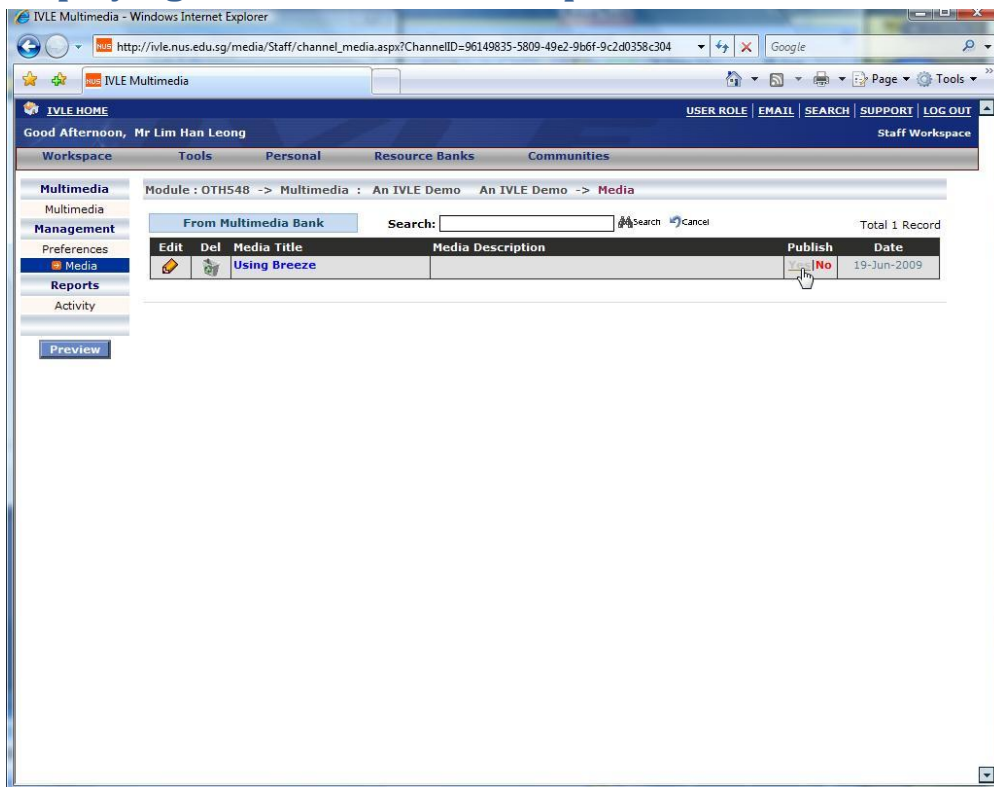
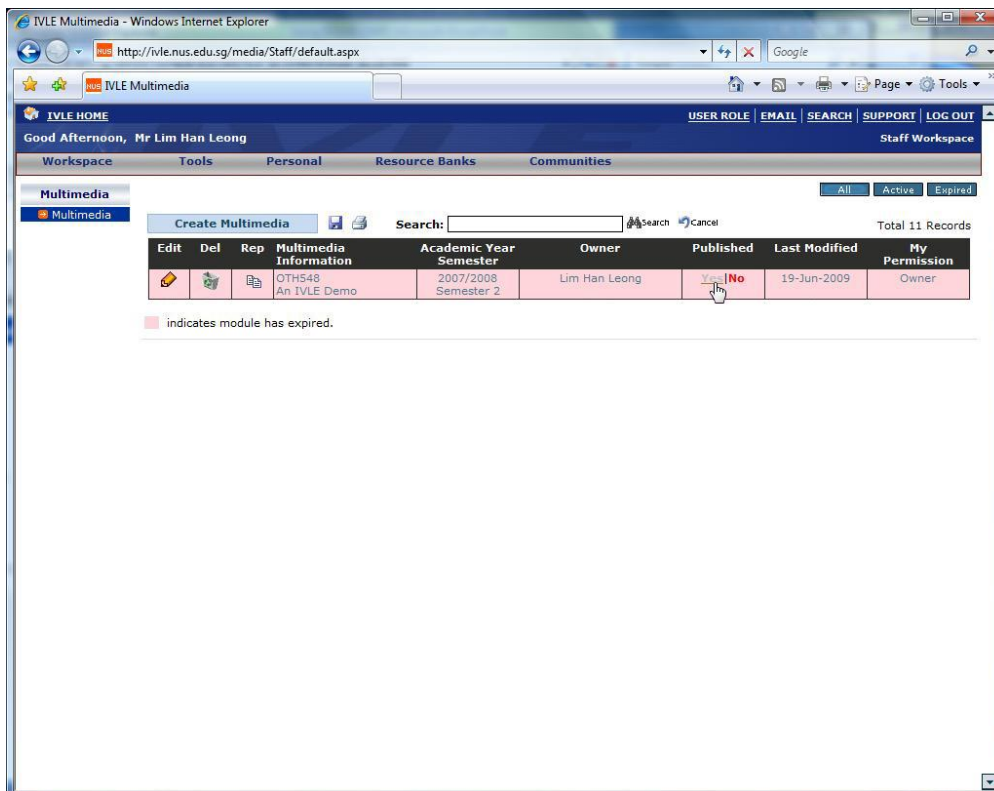


## Displaying Breeze in IVLE Workspace
